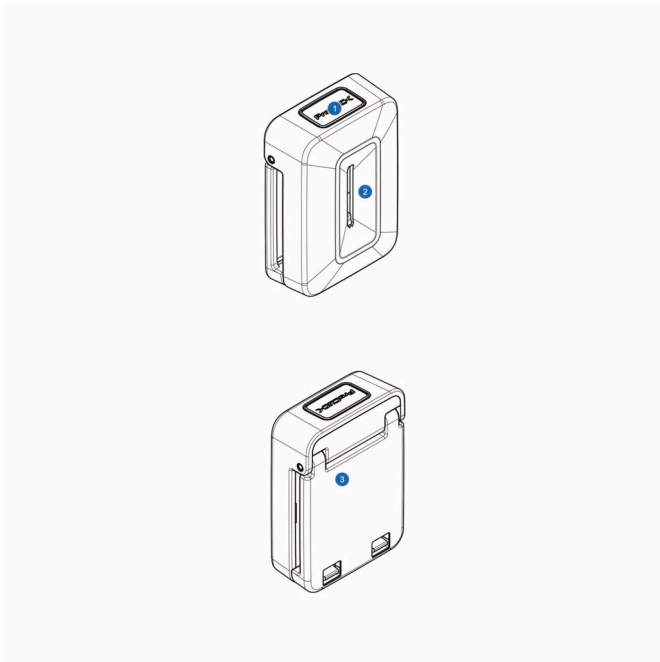

Description

The Holder is the heart of the ProClick system. It holds all the ProClick tool bags and can be combined across the board with all ProClick bags on the market. It is also compatible with all commercially-available straps with a max. width of 5 cm.

The Holder particularly practical in combination with the ProClick tool belt. This allows you to carry working materials on your person, a real relief when you are up a ladder, on scaffolding, and when you are working overhead. Everything you need is within easy reach.

The ProClick Holder has an active lock to safely transport the tool bag. There is a "click" when you connect the two, indicating that the hook on the bag has engaged and is fixed securely. You need to deliberately push the blue button to release it and this prevents the tool bag from self-releasing. This provides a significant safety factor, particularly when working up a ladder or on scaffolding.
